Dear Horsforth Resident

On Saturday, 6th May Horsforth will be celebrating the Coronation of The King and Queen Consort with activities and celebrations for the whole family. More details of the event will be revealed in due course, but for now, Horsforth Town Council in conjunction with the Horsforth Town Team, are launching three Coronation themed competitions which may be of interest to our community members.

- 1. Childrens' Design a Coronation themed poster:** to advertise our Horsforth Coronation Extravaganza celebration taking place on Saturday, 6th May. **Please include your school's name, your full name and your age recorded on the back of your poster.**
We need your A4 entries to be sent to our Horsforth Town Council Clerk, S White, at our Office at the Mechanics Institute, Town Street, Horsforth Leeds LS18 5B if possible, by Thursday, 30th March. However, we appreciate that the Easter Holidays are nearly upon us. Therefore, we can accept later entries, but they must be received by the latest, Thursday, 20th April please.
- 2. Coronation themed decorated front of house and gardens:** residents of Horsforth are invited to decorate the front of their homes and gardens for the Coronation. Judging will take place during the day of Friday 5th May in readiness for the day of the Coronation on Saturday, 6th May.
- 3. Fancy Dress Competition:** dress as King Charles or the Queen Consort Camilla – child category and adult category. Judging will take place on Saturday, 6th May during the Coronation celebrations on Town Street.

Winners of all the competitions will be announced and awarded their special Coronation themed prizes on Saturday, 6th May at around 3pm on the stage located near The Green at the bottom of Town Street.

Finally, not a competition, but something fun to do and get creative with. Please find attached a template to print out and design your own Royal Crown to wear over the Coronation celebrations. Simply print out the template on card in a colour of your choice and decorate in your own way. Use felt tip pens, paints, glitter or even stick on jewels. There is an option to incorporate fabric too if you have it to hand. We have included a PDF instruction manual to help you on your way.

We cannot wait to see all your wonderful creations! More details of what's going on around Horsforth for the Coronation will be announced soon.
