

The assembly of the PRINCE

ST. EDWARD'S CROWN



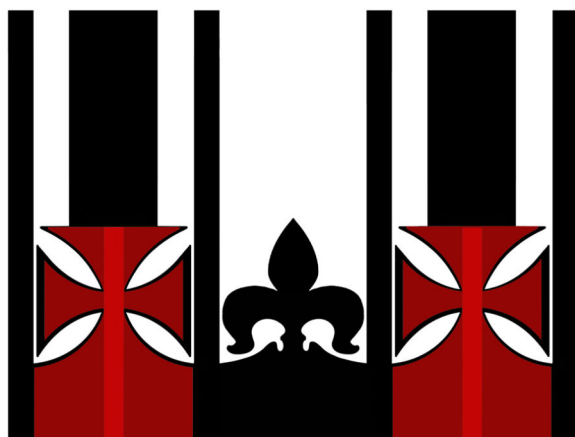
This Crown can be cut on both a 12" machine and a 8,5" machine
12" card stock: 4 pieces of card stock in the same color
A4 format card stock: 6 pieces of card stock in the same color

Cutting in my original size would give:
Circumference 52 cm / 20.4 inch
Height 23 cm / 9.0 inch

Heavy mirrored gold metallic card stock is used in my example
This is a great card stock for this Crown - shiny and stiff!

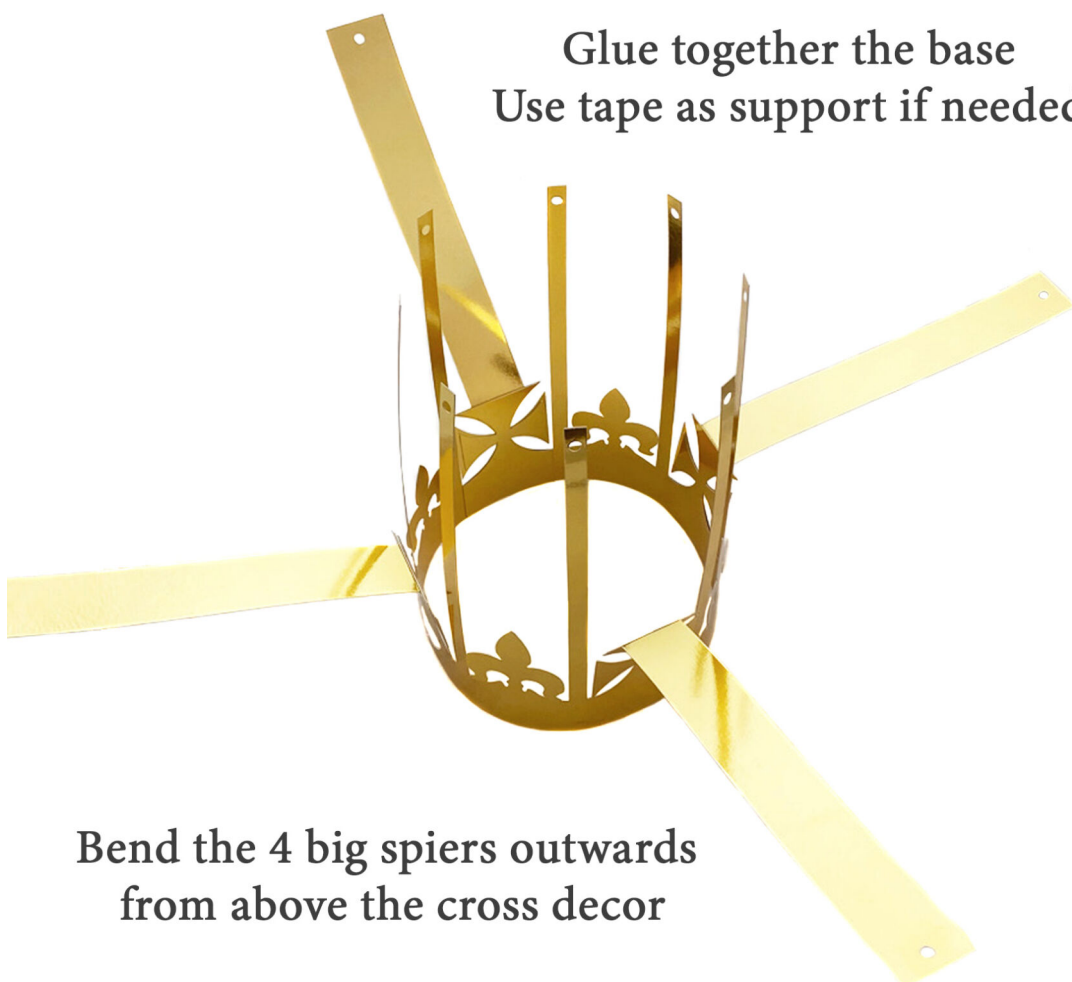
What you need





Glue the 4 support cross pieces behind the 4 cross decor
Glue 5 of the small borders together as extra support
and ad in the middle of the 4 cross decor
This is to make the whole base being stiff in
the upwards direction when the 4 big spiers are mounted

Glue together the base
Use tape as support if needed



Bend the 4 big spiers outwards
from above the cross decor



Make the fabric dome
Here used a velour cushion cover

Use any suitable fabric
You would need approx size 50 x 50 cm / 19.7 inch

Fold the fabric as shown here and optionally
use the template I have made
It is just a help to make a circle:)



Tip

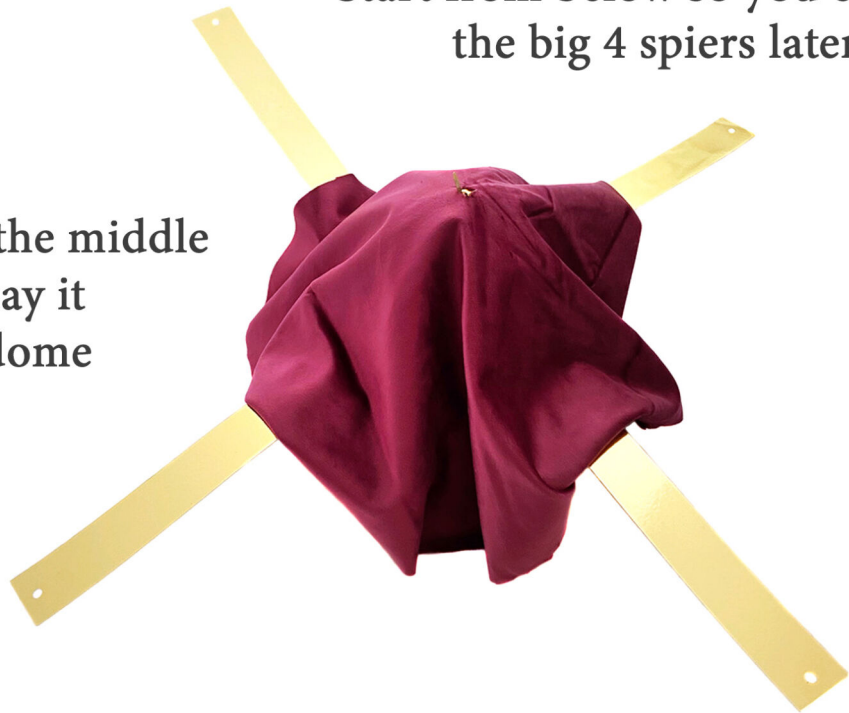
If the fabric is soft
just glue together folds inside
to make it stiffer when
the Crown is finished

Measure the height of the support spier
Make the height of the fabric
from the bottom up to the brad hole



Assembly the 8 small spiers randomly
with a brad /split pin
Start from below so you can add
the big 4 spiers later

Then cut a tiny hole in the middle
of the fabric and lay it
onto the Crown dome



Tuck the fabric inside
showing Fleur-de-lis
and hiding the smaller spiers

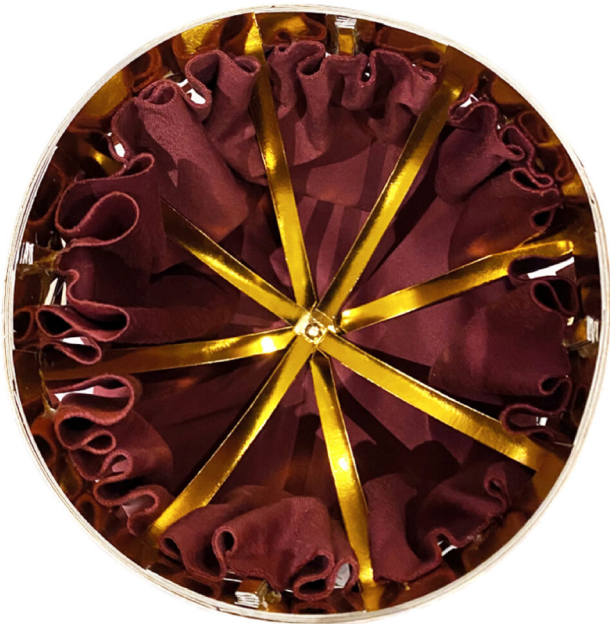




Ad the 4 big spiers onto the brad
and fold it outwards



A lot of fabric!
Even out the fabric
and glue it onto
the base of the Crown



Glue the top together
but leave the half circle
Bend the half circles outwards
and glue onto the top of the Crown



Now add the borders.
3-4 pieces on top of each other
to make them stand out



Ready
for decor!



Silver and gold ribbons

Various colored rhinestones
