### Community and Environment Committee Minutes Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023 at 7pm Mechanics Institute, Town Street, Horsforth, Leeds LS18 5BL

#### **CE/22.24 To accept apologies and the reason for absence**

No apologies received.

#### **CE/22.25 Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary and other Interests**

Cllr Garvani declared an interest in item CE/22.37.2.

#### **CE/22.26 To consider questions and comments from members of the public at the Chairman's discretion**

K. Roberts, the Leeds Neighbourhood Host for Horsforth was in attendance and gave an update about the Year of Culture which included the following:

- It is a year long event led by Leeds City Council and partners throughout Leeds.
- Local artists attend the schools in Horsforth to work with the pupils.
- There is a grant available for creative groups to apply for to show off their talents or create activities as part of it.
- A Creative Hub is being created in partnership with the Walk of Art as part of the Cultural Exchange Hub.

Two representatives from the Horsforth Town Team were in attendance to give an update about their plans for a Coronation Event. This was discussed. See item CE/22.30.3.

#### **CE/22.27 To approve the minutes of the Community and Environment Committee meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022.**

**Resolved** to approve the minutes of the meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022 as a true and accurate record.

#### **CE/22.28 Grant/Sponsorship**

Representatives from two of the organisations attended to present the applications.

The applications were considered, and it was **resolved** to recommend to the F&GP Committee on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2023 the following due the budget already being exceeded:

- a) To award sponsorship of £500 to Horsforth Churches Together towards the Good Friday Walk of Witness road closure costs.
- b) To award a grant of £400 to Horsforth Churches Together - Perfectly Pitched to provide accessible lunchtime concerts.
- c) To award a grant of £385 to 7th Airedale (St Margaret's) Scouts to improve the infrastructure of the Scout Hut.

It was noted that another application was submitted after the deadline and it was agreed that the Committee were unable to consider it.

### **CE/22.29 Good Citizen and Young Achiever Awards Scheme**

It was noted that the deadline for applications is October 2023 and the Clerk will continue advertising the scheme.

<p><b>Details of project/event</b></p> <p>Horsforth Community Garden has been growing since April 2021 on our site in front of the Japanese Gardens in Hall Park. Our aim is to create a beautiful garden for the whole community to enjoy, whether through taking part in gardening activities, picking produce to take away or just being in a peaceful natural space. The garden will include vegetables, herbs, fruit bushes, a mini orchard and a sensory garden. We will include compost heaps, water butts, bug hotels and a Little Veg Library for sharing produce, seeds, plants etc. We have a team of volunteers including a garden designer, a landscape gardener with experience of running a school garden, a medical herbalist, people with admin and financial skills as well as keen gardeners. I have attached an artist's impression of how the garden will look when it is finished.</p> <p>With a £500 contribution from Horsforth Town Council (Nov 2022) we raised £10,000 to pay for accessible paths which were installed in January 2023. A corporate group has provided the materials and labour to build our compost bays.</p> <p>We would now like to build raised beds for growing vegetables and herbs. A grant of £500 from Horsforth Town Council would be used together with our other fundraising to buy the materials (sleepers, coach bolts) to construct the raised beds.</p>
