Horsforth Town Council has adopted a Neighbourhood Plan, which means we are entitled to 25% of the CIL money generated in the Horsforth Town Council area to improve our environment and infrastructure.

<u>3&5 The Green Update</u>

For several years, Horsforth Town Council has been in discussion with Leeds City Council (LCC) over buying 3&5 The Green and The Stables.

The discussions started once it was known that LCC was going to move the Housing Office with the intention of the Town Council moving its office to 3 The Green and ensuring that Horsforth Museum was safe in 5 The Green. The move to 3 The Green would also mean that Horsforth would have a community room that would be available to hire for community groups. Unfortunately, the discussions stalled with the onset of the pandemic due to LCC officers isolating or becoming ill.

This all changed last year as we started the return to normal.

I am pleased to announce that we have completed the purchase of the lease and have taken possession of 3&5 The Green and The Stables. This does not affect the Museum or Horsforth Community Assets Project (currently using The Stables). There is a lot of work to be done before the Town Council can move into 3 The Green but we hope to make a start on this very soon.

We will keep you regularly infirmed on progress as we start this next stage in the Town Council's development.
