

Since the election, the new 3 & 5 The Green Advisory Group have met twice. The first meeting was, primarily, to fetch the new members of the group up to speed with where we were.

Since then, we have sent out the tender documents for the refurbishment of number 3 and received back bids for the work from several companies.

With advice from our architect and utilising the skills some of our new Councillors have, we have been able to choose a "preferred company" but are to have further discussions with them to ensure they are fully aware of what we need doing to number 3.

As a prelude to moving into the new office space in number 3, we will be moving our office from its current location behind the Library down to The Stables. There are some precursors that need completing (mainly phone and internet) but hope to be in The Stables by this September.
